## **Knots you MUST Know**

	The Figure 8 is a stopper knot. It is used to prevent the end of the rope from sliding through a pulley.
Figure 8 Knot	
Square Knot	The Square Knot or Reef Knot is used to join two rope of equal size.
Sheet Bend	The Sheet Bend is used to join two ropes of unequal size. The BLUE rope being the thicker diameter rope and the RED being the thinner diameter rope.
Cleat Hitch	The Cleat Hitch is used to secure a rope to a cleat on the dock or on the boat.
Bowline	The Bowline is used to make a loop at the end of a rope that will not slip.
Round Turn and Two Half Hitches	The Round Turn with Two Half Hitches is used to secure a rope to a post or a ring.
Clove Hitch	Simple all purpose knot. Easy to tie but can come lose or slip.
